The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The Cork University mortuary review into the disposal of perinatal organs is still ongoing. The SSWHG regrets the delay and acknowledges the disappointment for the families who have participated in the review process. A commitment to provide regular updates, to the families, has been given by the SSWHG.
