The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to your above Parliamentary Questions which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position:



A count of residential beds is taken at a point in time. From the last scoping exercise of residential rehabilitation and detoxification services provided directly by the HSE or Agencies that are in receipt of funding from the HSE, the following tables outline the position:

¹ In addition, there are 2 emergency beds that are used for observation (medical concern). These additional beds have been used for people in detox.

For the Deputy's information, new services have developed since the previous scoping exercises were completed, and some existing services have increased capacity. The HSE has commenced a scoping exercise to capture the number of facilities and current capacity of Tier 4 services, to be completed by end of Q1 2020. This will include capturing the current entry criteria for each facility.
