
**PQ Question:**

**To ask the Minister for Health if the shortage of car parking spaces at University Hospital Kerry will be addressed; if there is a plan to do this; how many extra parking spaces will be created; if the anticipated cost of the project is known if a timeline for delivery of the project exists; and if he will make a Statement on the matter.**

A scoping exercise is underway to maximise the provision of parking in UHK which does not conflict with the planned, orderly development of the campus.
