Response

Deputy Smyth,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Contracts awarded are put through a rigorous tendering process which includes specification and award criteria approved by the PEG (Project Evaluation Group).

Contract management is overseen by services users either locally or nationally. Where there is a performance issue by the supplier, it is documented by service users and addressed with the supplier. If the contract is not delivering to the specification outlined in the tender documents and has not been rectified to the required standard by the supplier, then the contract will be terminated.
