Dear Deputy Pringle,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Children; Equality; Disability; Integration and Youth for response. Due to the recent industrial action by management and administrative grade staff in Forsa union in the HSE, there were delays in the processing and answering of Parliamentary Questions. We apologise for any inconvenience this may have caused.

Capital funding of €0.1 million was allocated to progress the design for the new Intellectual Disability Adult Day Services facility at the Cleary Centre in Donegal town. A Design Team was appointed and the Preliminary Design (Stage 1) Report is expected to be complete in Q1 2024.

The approved capital budget for this project will be confirmed upon completion of detailed design & tender stage.
