Dear Deputy Kelly,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Due to the recent industrial action by management and administrative grade staff in Forsa union in the HSE, there were delays in the processing and answering of Parliamentary Questions. We apologise for any inconvenience this may have caused.

In response to this Parliamentary Question, please find enclosed a spreadsheet providing details on all Primary Care Centre (PCCs) built between 2016 and to date; the location of all primary care centres currently in construction, and the location of all primary care centres that are currently in development and further locations which are being planned.

The “Operational PCCs” (Appendix 1) tab lists the location of the 85 operational Primary Care Centres built since 2016 to date.

The second tab “PCCs in Construction” (Appendix 2) includes the details of 7 primary care centres which are currently in construction.

The third tab (Appendix 3) lists 44 locations where PCCs are in the process of being developed.



The HSE is planning a further 28 primary care centres which are listed in the fourth tab (Appendix 4).

Capital & Estates continue to work with Primary Care Services in developing additional Primary Care Centres to support delivery of health care needs into the future.
