"To ask the Minister for Health to provide a list of all vacancies for intellectual disability nursing positions in CHO4; the locations of the vacancies; and the impact of the HSE recruitment freeze on the filling of these positions."

Dear Deputy Cairns,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply to you in the context of the above Parlimentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth for response.

The HSE has a derogation process in place for the approval of key frontline positions in disability services. This includes nursing positions within the HSE and Section 38 organisations. The recruitment pause does not affect Section 39 agencies. The table below provides details of the current vacancies for Intellectual Disability Nursing posts in Cork and Kerry.

The HSE and its Section 38 and Section 39 Lead Agencies are operating in a very competitive global market for healthcare talent as there are significant shortages of qualified healthcare professionals across the globe.
