The Health Service Executive have been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted for the Minister for Health for a response.

Below is a table providing an overview of the waitlist figures categorised by area as of February 2024.

We regret that young people cannot always access the CAMHS service as quickly as they or we would like. Management in Cork Kerry Mental Health Services are actively taking every measure to acquire the necessary resources, clinical and otherwise, to ensure a quality service for the children going forward.

Recruitment challenges have faced several CAMHS teams in Cork Kerry Community Healthcare which, in turn, has affected waiting time targets. Local, national and international efforts are continuing in order to ensure that all available avenues are being explored to provide a staffing compliment for CAMHS services. We wish to reassure young people and their families that urgent cases are responded to on a priority basis. Referrals to CAMHS are prioritised according to their acuity and severity
