I refer to the above parliamentary question which was sent to me for direct response.

I have had this matter examined and am advised that in terms of the scheduling of outpatient appointments, St. Vincent's University Hospital currently has no delays in the booking of appointments. All appointments are booked in chronological order, depending on triage category. Waiting times can differ between each Department. Please advise if the above parliamentary question relates to a specific specialty and the matter can be examined further.
