To ask the Minister for Health the funding allocated to the National Office of Suicide Prevention, by year for 2019 to 2024, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy,

The HSE National Office for Suicide Prevention (NOSP) has been requested to respond to your question above.

The budget and expenditure of the NOSP has increased significantly in the last ten years, from €5.19m in 2012 to €14.65m in 2024.

Below is a breakdown of the yearly budget and the relevant expenditure for the HSE NOSP for the years specified.

Presently the HSE National Office for Suicide Prevention (NOSP) funds 21 national NGOs, all providing mental health or suicide prevention supports at different levels or to specific, targeted groups. Funding is in alignment with goals, objectives and actions in Connecting for Life, Ireland's National Strategy to Reduce Suicide. HSE Mental Health also funds 11 NGOs on a national basis and in alignment with Sharing the Vision – A Mental health Policy for Everyone.
