I refer to your recent parliamentary question in relation to staffing which was forwarded to the Health Services Executive (HSE) by the Department of Health for direct reply.

Emolument levels for the heath services are published on a monthly basis for personnel directly employed in the provision of Health & Social Care Services by the HSE and the various Section 38 hospitals & agencies through the Health Service Personnel Census (HSPC).

Details for each date as requested (May 2016, March 2020 and June 2020) by the Deputy form for each our staff groups are set out in the attached.

Workforce reports are available through the Health Services Personnel Census (HSPC), which is the official employment count for the public health service. The latest available employment information is routinely published <u>here</u>.
