The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Community Healthcare Organisation Dublin North City and County (CHO DNCC) Mental Health Services have a Section 38 Service Level Arrangement with St. Vincent's Hospital, Fairview to provide adolescent inpatient services to children where indicated. The service is currently registered with the Mental Health Commission for provision of 10 beds.
