To ask the Minister for Health when the new 50 bed St. Camillus Nursing home in Limerick will be opened; and when the 25 bed additional unit is planned to be open

Dear Deputy Kelly,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position:

I can confirm that St. Camillus Community Nursing unit (50 bed unit) is currently completing works that were highlighted at a HIQA inspection on 11th December 2023. These works are almost at completion, however opening of the unit is dependent on HIQA registration and funding approval for additional wte.

The 25 bed unit is currently delayed, as in order to progress works it is dependent on the opening of the 50 bed unit.

I trust this clarifies the situation, but should you require any further information or clarification in this matter, please do not hesitate to contact me.
