PQ Question: To ask the Minister for Health the amount the HSE has spent on salaries and fees for trainee clinical psychologists in each year of the past five years, in tabular form; the number of graduates from the programme; the number who went onto work for the HSE as qualified clinical psychologists in the past five years.; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Ward,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in relation to the above parliamentary question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have examined the matter and set out below the estimated amount the HSE has spent on salaries and fees for trainee psychologists from 2019 to 2023. Trainee clinical psychologists are recruited to trainee positions for the three years of their doctoral programme with an incremental scale over that time period. They are drawn from five university programmes with slightly different fees applying in each university.

It is noted that the number of graduates each year does not equate directly to a third of the total number of students. This relates to an increase in intake of students over the period shown as well as the fact that, for a



variety of reasons (e.g. maternity leave, long term sick leave, repeat placements), some students do not graduate within the intended three year cycle.

In relation to the numbers of graduates that take up posts in the HSE, the requested information is not available as it is not captured in the current recruitment application process. However estimates provided by psychology managers suggest a retention rate of 90% (HSE/S38/S39 combined).
