**PQ 5854/24** *“To ask the Minister for Health if the HSE has plans to refurbish Raheny Health Centre, Dublin 5; and the current services being provided at this health centre”* **Duncan Smith, TD**

Dear Deputy Smith,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Community Healthcare Organisation for Dublin North City and County (CHO DNCC) Primary Care Public Health Nursing (PHN) TEAM provide services from Raheny Health Centre.

A refurbishment took place in Raheny Health Centre in 2023 which included both internal and external changes. Internally, installation of a new public bathroom was commissioned along with new flooring and LED lighting throughout the building. Externally, new storage for clinical waste bins was erected along with the provision of a new shed the installation of a ramp at the front door and refurbishment is complete at this time.

The Raheny Health centre is located in the Kilbarrack Network. Clients currently have access to a full range of community services in Tonlegee Primary Care Centre. For an interim period while major refurbishment works are ongoing in the Kilbarrack Health Centre, clients may access community services at Edenmore Health Centre. The Kilbarrack Health Centre is due to re-open in Q4 2024.
