" To ask the Minister for Health the up to date position in respect of the delivery of a primary care centre for the Glanmire area in view of the fact that there has been a substantial increase in the population in the past 15 years; and if he will make a statement on the matter."

Dear Deputy Burke,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Following a process where submissions were requested from Developers for the development of a Primary Care Centre in the Glanmire area, a preferred solution was identified and a Letter of Intent issued to a Developer in April 2023. Engagement between HSE legal representatives and the Developers legal representatives addressed pre-lease enquiries and agreement reached on the draft Agreement for Lease and Service Level Agreement for the proposed property transaction. The site has been secured by the preferred developer and Glanmire will be lodged for planning in Q2 2024 after an extensive pre-planning process with Cork City Council.
