The Migraine Association of Ireland is a registered charity dedicated to improving the quality of life of people with Migraine. The Migraine Association of Ireland's mission is to assist, support and represent people living with Migraine and other headache disorders, while raising awareness of the nature of these conditions.

Community Healthcare Organisation, Dublin North City and County (CHO DNCC) Disability Services provides funding to the Migraine Association of Ireland each year through a Grant Aid Agreement.

I have set out below the amount of funding allocated to them for each of the years 2021, 2022 and 2023.
