To ask the Minister for Health the number of hospice care/palliative care beds in CHO5; the location of each; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above parliamentary question which was submitted to the Minster for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

The following outlines the total number of palliative care beds currently provided through Older Persons Services in CHO5/South East Community Healthcare:

In addition the CHO/ South East Palliative Care Centre (SEPCC) is located on the grounds of University Hospital Waterford and provides 20 inpatient beds for patients across the South East requiring specialist palliative care multidisciplinary team. Day services are also provided at SEPCC. The Community Specialist Palliative Care Teams provide palliative services in homes across the region.
