Re PQ - 56461/23- To ask the Minister for Health when a school dental service will be approved for children in 2nd, 3rd and 4th class in Tubber National School and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Minister Fleming,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outlined the position as follows.

Unfortunately the dental service is experiencing a significant backlog in the numbers of children waiting for  $6^{th}$  class school screening. Children are now receiving their  $6^{th}$  class examination in  $2^{nd}$  or  $3^{rd}$  year of secondary school. This is due to the reduced number of dentists in the area, with 3 dentists currently employed (2 of who are currently on long term leave for personal reasons) and 1.6 WTE dentist vacancies in Co Offaly since September 2022.

The waiting list for 6th class in Co Offaly is below as of April 2024:

Three campaigns have been run to fill these vacancies over the past two years but they have not resulted in any new employees. Since November 2023 there has been a pause on recruitment in the HSE, this has recently been lifted for dentists and the recruitment process has commenced again in this area. 1WTE agency dentist is due to commence work in Tullamore in May 2024.

Emergency dental treatment is available in Co. Offaly to all children under the age of 16 Monday to Friday.
