PQ 27895/24: To ask the Minister for Health if the regularity in which staff on leave with critical illness must submit sick certificates varies depending on their role/position in the HSE and CHO area; if so, the reason therefor; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Jackie Cahill

Dear Deputy,

I refer to your recent Parliamentary Question which was sent to the HSE for response.

The HSE Managing Attendance Policy and Procedure states: 'If an absence exceeds two continuous days a medical certificate must be submitted to the appropriate office on the third day of the absence. Follow-up certificates must be submitted on a weekly basis unless the employee is advised otherwise'. There is, therefore, local management discretion to request medical certificates at alternative intervals.

I trust this clarifies and is of some assistance.
