The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and following is the current position.

I wish to advise you that Mental Health Services currently have no funded partnership with Pieta in South Tipperary. South East Community Healthcare (SECH) Mental Health Services do not have a funding source to develop new contractual arrangements with other organisations. SECH Mental Health Services have scheduled a meeting to discuss such matters with the organisations national office.
