Dear Deputy Tóibín,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

National HR have informed me that their database of leavers does not go back as far as 2014 as requested in your PQ; however I can provide you with data from 2019 to Quarter 1 2024. Please see report attached. This data is a count of leavers by year and filtered by the care group of Acute Hospital Services and staff category of Nursing & Midwifery. Please note the caveats tab included which must be taken into consideration as leaver numbers also include moves to other health sector employers.
