PQ 30796/24 - To ask the Minister for Health to provide a detailed breakdown of the schedule of delivery for the 22 additional critical care beds provided for in the HSE National Service Plan 2024.

Dear Deputy Shortall,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

In NSP24, the HSE planned to increase the total number of funded critical care beds to 352 by the end of 2024. As of end of June 2024, there are 334 critical care beds available.

A further 18 critical care beds are profiled for delivery in 2024 as follows:
