Dear Deputy

Thank you for your Parliamentary Question referenced above, which has been forwarded to me for direct reply.

I regret information relating to the Cross Border Directive (CBD) scheme and the Northern Ireland Planned Healthcare Scheme (NIPHS) is not collated by procedure. I can confirm the information for the past five years as it relates to ophthalmology and I am setting the in tabular form information which I hope will be of assistance to you. Please also note that this relates to episodes of care and not to individual patients as one patient may have more than one episode of care e.g. an outpatient and day case treatment.

Number of reimbursements for ophthalmology treatment in the EU/EEA under the Cross Border Directive (CBD) and in the Private Healthcare Sector of Northern Ireland under the Northern Ireland Planned Healthcare Scheme (NIPHS).
