Recruitment with regard to Psychology has continued to be an area that proves challenging in filling of funded posts. We have received derogations with regard to filling of a number of psychology posts recently and these have been advanced to progressing stage. The recruitment pause was lifted on 15th July 2024 and the HSE South West is now operating under the Pay and Numbers Strategy 2024. Clarity on the details around WTE ceiling and posts approval process is underway which will give us an overview of our position once completed.
