PQ 31737/24: To ask the Minister for Health the number of people waiting to access lymphoedema services in Ireland in total and by waiting-time period, in each of the time periods Q1, Q2, Q3 and Q4 of 2023 and in Q1 and Q2 of 2024; and if he will make a statement on the matter. - John Brady

Dear Deputy Brady,

I refer to your parliamentary question, which was passed to the HSE for response.

### Community services

There are currently three specialist lymphoedema clinics in community services; Counties Clare, Meath and Donegal. The following data is combined for all 3 clinics.

In 2023 74% of priority 1 (P1) patients were seen within 4 weeks and 98% of priority 2 (P2) patients were seen within 12 weeks. In Q1 and Q2 2024 88% of P1 patients were seen within 4 weeks and 100% of P2 patients were seen within 12 weeks.

#### Acute services

There are acute lymphoedema services in the following hospitals which are for cancer related lymphoedema. In acute settings there is no waiting list as such, as the services are mostly provided expeditiously in an oncology context and the wait time is not generally recorded. The data available is presented by hospital. Details on a site by site basis are set out in the Appendix.

Following endorsement of the Lymphoedema /Lipoedema Model of Care (MOC) by the HSE in early 2019, approval was given by the HSE to move ahead with the planning for the MOC and initiate the implementation of the MOC through a Proof of Concept approach. This enabling approach commenced with 2 Proof of Concept sites -1 Specialist Lymphoedema Clinic (SLC) in Primary Care and 1 Early Detection Service (EDS) in Oncology and has further developed with 3 SLC's in the community and 2 EDS in the acute hospitals currently.

The Proof of Concept services are funded on a temporary year-to-year basis through an allocation of €904,740. Permanent funding in the order of €8m annually is required to enable the full roll out of the MOC. Resource of €2.2m is required in 2025 to permanently fund a Specialist Lymphoedema Clinic in each of the 6 Health Care Regions.
