"To ask the Minister for Health the number of WTE nurses working in Clonakilty Community Hospital in 2022, 2023 and to date in 2024, in tabular form".

Dear Deputy Smith,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Clonakilty Community Hospital is registered to provide long term, respite, transitional, palliative and dementia care to residents. Pre HIQA standards, our community hospitals were designed to accommodate a larger number of beds with many rooms housing multiple occupants. In common with many of our community hospitals, Clonakilty Community Hospital has undergone significant change and reconfiguration recently to comply with specific regulatory compliance requirements and also to meet the changing needs of residents with regard to their complexity.

Challenges in the health sector are ongoing and well-documented nationally in relation to recruitment and retention of staff with some of our more geographically remote locations experiencing increased pressures. The number and skill mix of staff in our community hospitals has to be appropriate to meet the needs of the residents living in the unit. Recruitment efforts are ongoing to maintain and enhance the services available to the Clonakilty community while ensuring that the maximum number of people that can be safely accommodated in Clonakilty Community Hospital are being accommodated.

Whole Time Equivalents (WTEs) may fluctuate throughout a given year at many of our Community Hospitals due to retirements, resignations, statutory leave etc. The table below sets out the average WTE nurses per year working at Clonakilty Community Hospital for the years 2022, 2023 and to date in 2024:

48.95 WTE	44.05 WTE	48.85 WTE
