PQ 32482/24*To ask the Minister for Health if arrangements can be made for the erection of a proper boundary wall at a location (details supplied: between Lakepoint housing estate and HSE Building Lakepoint Mullingar - there is currently a timber fence at this location but a proper wall needs to be built to discourage people climbing over the timberfence). -Robert Troy

Dear Deputy Troy,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question you submitted for response.

As previously communicated in response to your previous Parliamentary Question 18047/24 on 24th May 2024, Capital & Estates inspected the boundary from the residential estate side it appears that in all, but one area there is a substantial boundary wall circa 2.1 metres high constructed between the various residential estates and the HSE lands.

There is a section of the boundary at the South East corner of the HSE site that is only secured with a post and rail timber fence (as per photographs attached). It would appear that the boundary wall between the two Housing Developments to the rear of the site was not fully completed by either one or other of the developers or indeed possibly partially by both. There is circa 30 metres of post and rail timber fencing which is not adequately securing the Housing Estates from the HSE lands.



The Grant of Planning Permission for the Housing Developments in 2016 (which then had a subsequent application for an extension in 2021 and granted in 2022) included a condition to erect 2m high wall on this boundary and it is the responsibility of the developer(s) to construct this boundary wall. Westmeath County Council may be best placed to provide a resolution to this matter.
