**To ask the Minister for Health the services currently in place at the Primary Care Centre (PCC) in Dromod, County Leitrim; and the plans in place to increase the level of services in the same PCC.**

Dear Deputy Harkin

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position for Community Healthcare Cavan Donegal Leitrim Monaghan Sligo.

There are three clinic rooms in the Dromod Health Centre, in which the following Primary Care Services are currently provided;

- The Public Health Nursing Service holds twelve child health clinics per month.
- The School Immunisation Service holds two vaccination clinics per month.
- The Community Medical Service holds four clinics per month.
- There is one Diabetic Retina Screening clinic per month.
- Dr. Dolan holds a G.P. clinic on Monday and Tuesday.
- Dr. Helena Traskowska-Fangor holds a G.P. clinic on Thursday and Friday.

In addition, occasional clinics e.g. Flu clinics are held on site.

As space is very limited in Dromod Health Centre, it would be difficult to facilitate an increase in the level of services operated in it. Currently, other services avail of Carrick on Shannon Primary Care Centre, as an alternative location.
