Dear Deputy Troy,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question you submitted for response.

At this point in time there are services operating within the main building at St Loman's Hospital and the property has not been identified as surplus to requirements.

In line with the HSE Property Protocol and the Department of Public Expenditure, NDP Delivery and Reform Circular 11/15 *Protocols for the Transfer and Sharing of State Property Assets* and Circular 17/2016 *Policy for Property Acquisition and for Disposal of Surplus Property* the HSE to advise the Land Development Agency once a property is identified as being surplus to requirements.

Should the building become fully vacant and the HSE has no other requirements for it then the Land Development Agency will then be notified.
