Dear Deputy O'Callaghan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 25197/24), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Currently the Primary Card Reimbursement Service require one DPSR1 application form to be completed with every DPS refund request.

However the PCRS is currently scoping an online solution for DPS Refunds and we are in the early stages of introducing an electronic fund transfer system. Due to competing priorities and a number of technical issues that must be addressed relating to the project, development will take time before we can go live with electronic fund transfer to individual clients.
