To ask the Minister for Health about mental health funding for voluntary mental health organisations in Wexford, and how much was allocated from 2020 to present; how groups can apply for funding; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Ward,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

Mental Health Services provide funding for two voluntary organisations with the Wexford area, since 2020 the total funding provided was €327,617.45 allocated through service arrangement.

All funding is applied for through submission of a funding application form available for download from the HSE website. Applications are reviewed through CMSU (Contract Management Support Unit) and allocated to relevant care group.
