I refer to the above representation:

The Enhanced Community Care (ECC) programme for Cardiology commenced in July 2023 and continues to develop in tandem with the Acute Cardiology service in Mayo University Hospital, in line with the Galway Saolta processes.

The ECC programme streamlines the patients from Acute Cardiology in Mayo University Hospital to the Integrated Care Cardiology Hub. This is a Consultant led service which is supported by Clinical Nurse Specialist and Cardiac Rehabilitation teams.

The programme is in its early stages and will continue to develop over the coming months and years to ensure a positive impact on waiting times for patients and overall quality of care for Cardiology patients.
