Dear Deputy Ó Broin,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (PQ 13380/24) which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Public Health Nurses are healthcare professionals who provide a range of nursing services in the community including child development assessments in line with the National Healthy Childhood Programme. The Community Healthcare Organisations (CHOs) track waiting lists on a continuous basis and ensure they prioritise the provision of care for those identified as having the greatest needs and the highest risk within the overall resource. The geographic catchment areas for Primary Care Teams and Primary Care Networks are defined nationally by CHO based on population figures.

We do not currently offer the option of attending an alternative CHO location for child development checks. Where PHN shortfalls arise, we work to ensure services are focused on identifying and supporting patients who have the greatest need by enabling staff to be deployed where necessary to support these children. HSE management work in conjunction with the local areas to monitor performance and address issues as they arise.

Child development checks remain a priority and any parents with a concern should contact their GP or local Public Health Nursing service.
