Dear Deputy Carthy,

I refer to your parliamentary questions above which have been referred to me for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The Director of Nursing for Cavan Monaghan Disability Services Respite Services has advised that the criteria for accessing Annalee View Respite Centre was not amended in relation to adults. All respite centres for adults with Intellectual Disabilities across HSE Community Healthcare Cavan, Donegal, Leitrim, Monaghan, Sligo (CH CDLMS) operate in line with their Adult Disability Services access policy.

Please find attached Statement of Purpose and Admission Policy.
