Dear Deputy Shortall,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in regard to your parliamentary question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for a response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The Health Service Executive can confirm that the attached is a breakdown of the number of Public Health Nursing vacancies in each Community Health Network in CHO7. The Public Health Nursing Service is experiencing a significant shortage of Public Health Nurses (PHN), Community Registered Nurses, and Health Care Assistants. There has been detailed planning of work at site-specific levels to proactively manage the impact of staff retirements, staff transfers, staff vacancies, maternity leave, and sick leave (short and long-term) on front-line services.
