To ask the Minister for Health the amount spent on addiction services in 2023 by local authority area, in tabular form.

Dear Deputy Ó Broin,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to your above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position:

HSE expenditure by local authority are not readily available, however, for the Deputy's information please find below HSE expenditure attributed to Addiction in 2023, which has been split by Community Health Organisation, and notes National Addiction Expenditure which includes National Drug Treatment Centre (NDTC), National Social Inclusion Office (NSIO) and the Primary Care Reimbursement Service (PCRS).
