Dear Deputy Ryan,

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Children; Equality; Disability; Integration and Youth to the Health Service Executive for direct response. I have requested that a member of Disability Services examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

In 2013, the Department of Health closed the Mobility Allowance Scheme to new applicants.

The HSE funds IWA as an independent legal entity, pursuant to Section 39 of the Health Act, in order to provide a range of supports and services to people with a disability. The Irish Wheelchair Association has received funding from the HSE for vehicles for transportation of clients.

The IWA may also apply for National Lottery funding for provision of vehicles. Funding for projects under the national lottery is made available annually and is advertised in local press and media usually in mid-January with a closing date in mid-February each year.
