The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Questions, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The National Ambulance Service has now completed the review of the privileging process, following stakeholder engagement. A new policy has been developed and approved by the NAS Executive. It is planned to present the programme in Quarter one, next year, if the need arises and in-line with operational requirements.
