Children's Health Ireland (CHI) Response:

Children's Health Ireland (CHI) can advise that there is no Gastroenterology service at CHI at Temple Street, this service is delivered from our CHI at Crumlin site.

CHI at Crumlin is the primary location for delivering our Gastroenterology, Hepatology, intestinal failure and transplant medicine service and is currently conducting two Gastroenterology outpatient clinics on a daily basis.

In addition, there is one Gastroenterology outpatient clinic per week at CHI at Tallaght.
