To ask the Minister for Children; Equality; Disability; Integration and Youth the number of children waiting longer than six months for AON assessment in Clare; how long they are waiting, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Wynne

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Children; Equality; Disability; Integration and Youth.

There are currently 76 children waiting longer than 6 months for an AON assessment in Clare. The table below outlines the numbers in order of waiting time;
