To ask the Minister for Health the total investment in the National Ambulance Service in each of the years 2011 to 2025 inclusive; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Colm Brophy

Dear Deputy

The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The National Ambulance Service (NAS) serves as the statutory provider of pre-hospital emergency and intermediate care for the Irish State. Its funding comes from two primary sources: **Revenue**, which covers daily operational expenses, and **Capital**, which supports the maintenance and development of the NAS infrastructure and vehicle fleet.
