To ask the Minister for Health the number of assaults recorded against patients at HSE facilities for each quarter for each of the years 2019 to 2024, inclusive, in tabular form.

Dear Deputy Cullinane

Thank you for your representation. Incident reporting is impacted by a number of factors and is not intended as a data collection point but primarily aids as a system that helps incident management and learning from such events. There are data limitations which include potential duplication of incidents, variance in reporting and variance in data validation. The majority of incidents had no harm or low level harm reported. In some instances the reported event has been recorded as an 'allegation' and it is not confirmed if the event occurred. The definition of Incidents in the HSE is described in the **Incident Management Framework 2020** (page 41), which can be accessed on our website here
