PQ Number: 43632/24

To ask the Minister for Health the number of permanently funded community beds in the health system in each year from 2016 to 2024, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Niamh Smyth

I note the Parliamentary Question references the term **permanently funded**, therefore we have referenced facilities that are publicly managed or come under Section 38 criteria. Please advise if this is not what is meant in your PQ as permanently funded.
