Dear Deputy McAuliffe,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Questions you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

I am pleased to advise you that Community Healthcare Organisation Dublin North City and County (CHO DNCC) is utilising the Coolock Primary Care Centre to its full capacity. This includes enabling access to clinical and meeting rooms which contribute to the development and provision of services within the Coolock Network.

The following services are currently being provided from HSE Coolock Primary Care Centre:

Since opening, the services provided in the Coolock Primary Care Centre have continued to evolve to meet service demand. This includes the Children's Disability Network Team for the Coolock Network and some outreach services for the Dublin North/Beaumont Chronic Disease Team as detailed in the table above.

In addition to this, a podiatry service for Dublin North area based in the Coolock Primary Care Centre is currently under discussion. A Social Inclusion Liaison Officer has recently been assigned to the centre along with a Social Inclusion pilot scheme for SAOR (Support Ask and Assess, Offer Assistance, Refer) alcohol programme.

The Centre was also re-configured into the Coolock Community Health Network structure, with the appropriate management structure in place to support this and the ongoing development of our services. The GP Lead for the Coolock network is also in post, the first of the GP Leads to be appointed in the Dublin North area.
