HSE Response

Action Plan for Disability Services 2023-2026

The Action Plan for Disability Services 2024-2026, sets out a three year programme designed to tackle the deficits highlighted in the *Disability Capacity Review to 2032*, which identified the demand for specialist community-based disability services arising from demographic change, and considerable levels of unmet need.

The Action Plan is designed to provide additional funding for developments that will help build capacity within services, so that the benefits of these funding increases will be felt directly by the service user. This will also help the HSE in dealing with some of the key cost-drivers in service delivery giving greater flexibility and control when planning services.



A20.5 Implement Children's Disability Network Teams Information Management System.

The rollout of the CDNTMIS across the 93 CDNTs.

50 CDNTs are now live on CDNTIMS, including all HSE led teams. Migration of remaining 43 section 38/39 lead agencies is on hold until data protection matters, currently in deliberations, are resolved.
