PQ 1670/25* To ask the Minister for Health the status of the provision of a primary care centre for Glanmire, Cork; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Pádraig O'Sullivan

Dear Deputy O'Sullivan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The Primary Care Centre in Glanmire will be delivered via the HSE operational lease mechanism. Following a process where submissions were requested from developers for the development of a Primary Care Centre in the Glanmire, a preferred solution was identified and following approval by the Board of the HSE, a Letter of Intent issued to the developer.

The developer confirmed to the HSE that an application for planning permission for the Primary Care Centre in Glanmire was lodged with Cork City Council in August 2024. The HSE have been informed that planning permission has been refused for Glanmire Primary Care Centre on 27th January 2025.

In light of this decision the HSE will now explore all options for the delivery of a Primary Care Centre in the area.
