To ask the Minister for Health if the situation of only one part-time palliative care social worker covering all of counties Laois and Offaly will be rectified, given other counties with a similar population have two fulltime palliative care social workers.

Dear Deputy Stanley

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outlined the position as follows.

Currently there is one Senior Social Worker on the Laois/Offaly Palliative Care Team working 3 days per week (0.6WTE).

An additional Senor Social Worker post has been sought from the National Service Plan for 2025 and I anticipate that this will be approved.
