Dear Deputy Carthy,

I refer to your parliamentary question above which has been referred to me for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Children Disability Services:

The Enable Ireland Children's Disability Network Manager (CDNM) Cavan has advised as follows in relation to the current Occupational Therapy (OT) staff compliment:

The Disability Manager for Children's Disability Network Teams (CDNTs) in Community Services Cavan, Donegal, Leitrim, Monaghan, Sligo (CS CDLMS) has advised that under the Progressing Disability Services (PDS) model, CDNT offers therapeutic support to children and young people (0-18 years) via the interdisciplinary model. CDNTs do not break down the therapeutic input for children and young people into single discipline waiting lists as per the PDS model. Therefore, intervention is based on children from 0-18 years of age and the relevant waiting list metrics captured are as follows:

Should additional development funding be provided to the HSE CS CDLMS Disability Services by the Department of Children, Disability, Equality, Integration & Youth in its budget allocation to create additional OT posts in Cavan then recruitment will be progressed by the relevant service provider – HSE or Enable Ireland. The need for continued investment in multidisciplinary supports for adults and children with disabilities has been identified by the aforementioned service providers.
