Please see below services available to those persons living with a neurological condition in Co.Meath:

Prosper Meath | Intellectual Disability Services & Supports

Prosper Meath provide Intellectual Disability Services & Supports to adults with an intellectual disability in the Meath catchment area.

<u>Enable Ireland provide a Home and Community Support Service</u> to people with primarily physical and sensory disabilities living in County Meath Adult Services.

<u>Headway Brain Injury Services and Support</u> as a lifeline for people living with Acquired Brain Injury in Ireland.

Navan Day Service Praxis

Navan Day Service provides a New Directions-led service to adults with intellectual disabilities and autism. The service is centrally located.

Irish Wheelchair Association Day Service

Navan Day Service provides a New Directions-led service to adults with intellectual disabilities and Physical and Sensory Disability.

<u>Dunboyne Day Service Praxis Care</u>

Dunboyne Day Service is a day service for adults located in the Dunboyne, Meath area. We support adults with mental ill health, intellectual disabilities.

Meath Adult Disability Service.

(18-65 years) Physical and Sensory, (18yrs -till end of life) Learning Disability

The Meath Adult Disability Team co-ordinates community services for adults aged 18-65 years with disabilities of a neurological nature and/or intellectual disability and /or autistic spectrum disorder, living in the Meath Primary care area who require services greater than can be provided by their local Primary Care.

Acquired Brain Injury Ireland

Provide support to those aged 18-65 with acquired brain injuries.
